

ADMISSION NOTICE (2019)

Masters of Arts (Communication & Journalism) MACJ & Masters of Arts (Public Relations) MAPR

The two programmes are spread over four semesters. The first two semesters have four subjects each. The third semester has electives out of which the students select five. The fourth semester has two subjects and a research dissertation. The course is open to students of any stream (Arts/Science/Commerce).

There will be an entrance involving a written test, an interview and a group discussion. All of these revolve around the student's language skills, general awareness of what is going on in the field of media and current affairs and the student's motivation in selecting this programme. The written test can be attempted in Hindi, English or Marathi.

Following documents are to be attached with the application form:

- 1) Graduation all semester Mark sheets.
- 2) Caste Certificate (If applicable)
- 3) Educational Gap Certificate ORIGINAL (If any Educational Gap)
- 4) Statement of Purpose.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Students can download the form from college website (<http://www.hindujacollege.in/>) and pay Rs. 100 at the time of form submission. Outstation candidates can courier the completed application forms to the college address. Candidates are required to get their form submission receipts of Rs 100, at the time of written test.
- 2) Application must be completed in all respects and must be submitted to the College office on or before June 28, 2019 before 4 pm.
- 3) A list of Students selected for admission to M.A. (C&J) /M.A. (PR) Part I Course will be exhibited on the college website.
- 4) Students selected for admission are required to enrol themselves within the stipulated time frame mentioned.
- 5) Persons who are graduates of Universities other than the University of Mumbai are required to submit the Migration Certificate within one week of taking admission. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to get the Migration Certificate and Mark Sheets from his/her University in time and not that of the college. In case the applicant is not able

to get the migration certificate in time, their admission is liable to get cancelled and no refund of the fees will be given.

- 6) The Application must be accompanied with Statement of Purpose (max. 500 words) stating why the applicant wants to join the course. (Any language Hindi/Marathi/ English).
- 7) All Relevant documents related to Caste need to be attached along with the admission form. Admission will be considered against respective categories strictly against valid documents. Reservation benefits will be given to Maharashtra state domicile candidates only.
- 8) Students are requested to check the college website for further notices, updates, list of selected candidates, fees structure etc
