Note: The total amount considered for the refund of fees from the commencement of term of the courses include the following

- · All the fee items chargeable for one year are as per relevant University circulars for different faculties (excluding the courses for which the total amount is fixed by other competent authorities)
- The fees charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as University share (including Vice Chancellor fund, University fee for sports and cultural activities, E-charge, disaster management fund, examination fee and Enrolment fee) are non-refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation.
- · Fees collected for Identity Card and Library Card, Admission form and prospectus, enrolment and any other course specific fees are NOT REFUNDABLE after the commencement of the academic term.
- · All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be refunded at the time of cancellation.
- · Provided that wherever admissions are made through centralised admission process for professional and/or for any other courses by other competent authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admissions. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, **0.2859** is applicable for cancellation of admission.
- · Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses.
