Masters of Arts (Communication & Journalism) MACJ - I

Masters of Arts (Public Relations) MAPR- I

MACJ & MAPR programs, affiliated to University of Mumbai are two years programs with four semesters in all. The first two semesters have four subjects each. The third semester has elective subjects. The students have to select any five. The fourth semester has two subjects and a research dissertation.

As per University guidelines, applicants are required to appear for entrance test, an interview and group discussion, in order to test the student's language skills, current affairs and update in the field of media and student's motivation in selecting this programme.

Applicants are requested to submit following documents with the application form:

- 1) Graduation all semesters marks sheets.
- 2) Caste Certificate (If applicable)
- 3) Educational Gap Certificate ORIGINAL (If any educational gap)
- 4) Statement of Purpose.

- 1) Students seeking admission in above programs need to fill the Google form **<https://forms.gle/2kVDofRJ9QiHS621A>**
- 2) Application must be complete in all respect and must be submitted online before July 29, 2021 before 12 noon.

- 3) List of selected applicants for the above programs will be displayed on the college website (<https://hindujacollege.in>)
- 4) Selected applicants are required to enrol themselves within 3 days from the date of notification.
- 5) Applicants graduating from Universities other than University of Mumbai are required to submit Migration Certificate within one week of taking admission. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to get the Migration Certificate and Mark Sheets from his/her University in time. In case the applicant is not able to get the migration certificate in time, their admission is liable to get cancelled and no refund of the fees will be given. (Please Note: **Admission of selected students will be provisional subject to confirmation from the University of Mumbai**)
- 6) The application must be accompanied with Statement of Purpose (max. 500 words) stating why the applicant wants to join the program.
- 7) All relevant documents related to caste must be attached along with the admission form. Admission will be considered against respective categories strictly against valid documents.
